1. Why have you applied for the Girls Leading in Advanced Manufacturing program?

2. What are your interests and hobbies?

E.g. "I love anything that is creative. I enjoy the process of making things – from clothes and cushions to candles and face products"

3. Have you ever taken a leadership role? Please explain?

E.g. "I am my house captain at school which means that I have to represent my house and communicate effectively on their behalf. I think this displays leadership qualities. In group activities at school I am usually the one who will get the group to work together effectively".

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4. What do you know about the manufacturing / engineering / trades industry?

E.g. "I do know that Geelong is a place with many advanced manufacturing businesses. My next door neighbour is a chemical engineer at 'Viva' in North Shore. He has told me that Viva Energy Australia supplies around a quarter of all Australia's petroleum products, including: petrol, LPG, diesel, aviation fuel, bitumen and solvents.

5. Can you name at least two manufacturing companies in Geelong and explain what they produce?

E.g. "LyondellBasell is a very large manufacturing company in Geelong. I searched on the internet and found that they are a global leader in polyefins and the only manufacturer of polypropylene in Australia. Boundary Bend Olive Company in Lara grows 2.2 million trees and processes them into olive oil."
